## FAQs for the *New* Colorbond Fencing Range

### 1. Why have the colours changed?

To meet the requests of customers and reflect market trends. It's been almost 15 years since the last colour refresh!

### 2. When are the new colours available?

You can order them now. The new colours have been rolled and Metroll have stock of 1.8m high fencing.

### 3. What happens if I want to order one of the colours that **have been moved to the Secondary Range**?

It depends on the colour.

For **Night Sky**, **Cottage Green** and **Red Oak**: From 1st April 2016 these colours will not be available in rolled stock. When our coil stock for these colours is depleted they will be available as Secondary Range colours only.

For **Bushland**, **Deep Ocean** and **Harvest**: From 1st April 2016 these colours will not be available in rolled stock, however they will be available with a 3 day lead time. Metroll will endeavour to hold coil for these colours until the end of 2016, at which stage these colours will be available as Secondary Range colours only.

### 4. What happens if I want to order one of the **other** colours in the Secondary Range?

The Secondary Range is only available on application. These colours require minimum order quantities, a lead time and have a price premium attached to them.

### 5. What about the Extended Range, are those colours available?

The Extended Range is only available on application. These colours require minimum order quantities, a lead time and have a price premium attached to them.

### 6. Why do the existing colours need a new name?

Many of the colours in the fencing range are exactly the same colours in the Roofing Range, calling them the same name makes sense. Take a look at the other side of this flyer and you can see the former name and the new name.

Some fence colours have no roofing equivalent so will stay the same name. These include Domain and Riversand. Please note Classic Cream is very similar to Domain but is not an exact match.

### 7. Where can I see the new colours?

Metroll has swatches of all the new colours available. A fan deck has also been included in your event bag, please take one as you leave. You can also visit the Colorbond website.

### 8. Can I get the new range in both Trimclad and Harmony profiles?

Absolutely.
